Children's Day: Thursday and Friday until 2:00 p.m. Bring the whole family and spend the day!! Bring blankets or chairs to sit on.

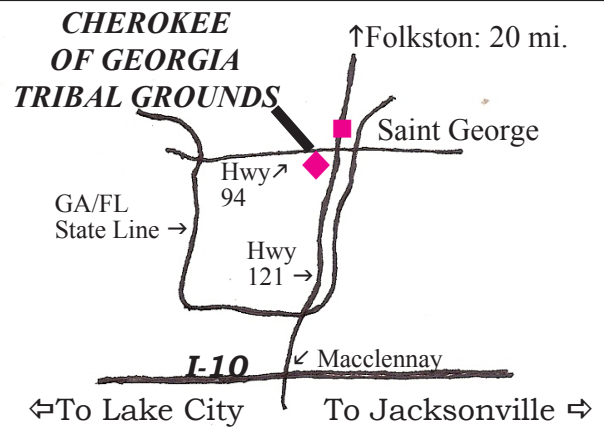
